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LAKE FOREST CLIMATE SURVEY 2026

Thank you to everyone who took the time to participate in the 2026 Community Climate Survey. We received 275 responses from residents across Lake Forest, providing valuable insights into how members view our community, amenities, communication efforts, and priorities moving forward.

The purpose of this survey was not simply to gather opinions, but to better understand what matters most to our residents and to identify opportunities for improvement. Your feedback will help guide future discussions, priorities, and planning efforts as the Board works to make informed decisions on behalf of the community. Based on the response rate, the results provide a statistically meaningful snapshot of resident sentiment and offer a useful benchmark for measuring progress over time. As with any survey, the results reflect a variety of perspectives. In some areas there was strong agreement, while in other areas opinions were more divided. We view that diversity of thought as a strength. The survey highlights many things residents appreciate about Lake Forest while also identifying areas for improvement.

To ensure transparency, we are sharing the aggregated results exactly as they were reported. Individual comments and identifying information have been excluded to protect privacy and encourage candid participation. The Board will continue to review the data, discuss priorities, and seek practical opportunities to address the themes that emerged from the survey. We appreciate your engagement and your willingness to share your thoughts. Strong communities are built through participation, and surveys like this help ensure that resident voices are heard as we plan for the future of Lake Forest. Thank you for helping shape that future.-
