How to address Neighborhood Concerns!

In accordance with the Lake Forest House and Ground Rules and to help resolve issue as efficiently as possible, we ask that residents first attempt to speak directly with their neighbor in a respectful manner. Many concerns can be resolved through open communication.

If you have already spoken with your neighbor and the issue remains unresolved, please send in an email to lfarc@lakeforestdaphne.com with the following information.

Date(s) and time(s) of the issue

A brief description of the concern

Date and outcome of your conversation with your neighbor

Any supporting photos or documentation

The action you are requesting the Association/Management to consider

Once we receive the information, we will review the matter and determine the appropriate next steps in accordance with the community governing documents.

The Architectural Department is required to follow the established enforcement process. Upon verification of a violation, a notice will be issued, followed by inspections every ten (10) days for a period of 30days.

If the violation remains unresolved after 30 days, fines may be assessed and the matter may be referred to the Association's legal counsel for further action.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping maintain a positive neighborhood environment.

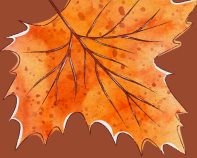
