

Notes from the President LFPOA June 2020

Pools! Pools! Pools!
Everyone wants to know when our three pools will open for the season.

The answer is, soon but I can't say exactly when.

The Alabama Department of Public Health has eased capacity restrictions on pools, no longer limiting the area to 10 people. But everyone in the pool, on the deck or in the recreation areas has to maintain the 6-foot social distancing.

We're trying our best to consider how to get the pools open and comply with the current COVID-19 restrictions. It might mean accepting appointments to use the pools so we can comply with social distancing in the water and on the decks.

These factors and others lead to the question of how we monitor the restrictions at the pools and what the Association can afford to spend on monitoring and sanitization of rest rooms and repeatedly used surfaces, such as chairs.

We'll get the pools open as rapidly as possible, I promise you that.

General Manager Erik Tanner's team has ordered sanitization supplies and pool chemicals, so we can begin bringing the pools up again after this unanticipated period of dormancy. I'm hoping the run on pool chemicals doesn't turn into a toilet paper panic because of high demand and limited supplies.

Fore and Fault

We've successfully reopened the golf course to socially distanced play, and we're back to nearly normal at the tennis club.

With the exception of immediate families playing together, golf play is limited to one person per cart. Like many courses, we have created “touchless” golf around the greens. There are no trap rakes, and the cup has been raised so players don't have to reach in for their ball. Remember, there is no drinking water on the course during this time, so be sure you can stay hydrated.

The 19th Hole grill has reopened for takeout orders and curbside pickup. Social distancing is still required inside the club building.


Singles and doubles play has resumed at the tennis club, but all players must wear gloves. Be mindful of social distancing when gathering before or after matches.

And here's a little secret for those who want to get in a good walk: the original nine-hole course along the lake — what we now call Daphne Central Park — has never closed. Stroll the former holes or play disc golf; it's free.

We're still working on when the Yacht Club may re-open for drinks and dining. I hope that we might use some of this down time to get some of our easier renovations under way.

Our stables continue to operate with lessons in small groups by appointment; again with social distancing.

I know many of you like to attend our monthly work sessions and official called meetings, and I want to get back to that as soon as it is safe. We tried a Zoom meeting last month among board members, and are looking at ways to open the meetings to a remote audience if possible.

1. Place butter on grid-

dle. Put tortilla on griddle and add cheese.

2. Sauté on griddle chonizo, peppers, on-

ions. Then add eggs and scramble until soft. Place in Quesadilla and fold over and let cook for 2 min.

3. Fry tortilla

4. Serve with salsa and sour cream

Red Candy Apples

Ingredients

- » 8 Medium Apples (Red Delicious or Granny Smith)
- » 8 Flat Wooden Skewers or Spoons
- » 2 cups Granulated Sugar
- » 1 cup Light Corn Syrup
- » 1/2 cup Water
- » 1/4 cup Red Cinnamon Candles
- » 5-10 drops Red Food Color

Prepare Apples:

1. Wash and dry the apples; remove the stems and insert skewers into the stem ends. Place on a greased baking sheet.
2. In heavy 2-quart saucepan, stir together the sugar, corn syrup and water. Stirring constantly, cook over medium heat until the mixture boils and the

sugar is dissolved.

3. Continue cooking without stirring until the temperature reaches 250 degrees on a candy thermometer or until a small amount of the mixture dropped into very cold water forms a ball which is hard enough to hold its shape, yet pliable.

4. Add the cinnamon candies and continue cooking until temperature reaches 285 degrees on a candy thermometer or until a small amount of the mixture dropped into very cold water separates into threads which are hard but not brittle.

5. Remove from the heat. Stir in the food color.
6. Hold each apple by its skewer and quickly twirl in syrup, tilting pan to cover the apple.



7. Remove from the syrup; allow the excess to drip off, then twirl to spread the remaining syrup smoothly over the apple.

8. Place on a greased cookie sheet to cool. (If the mixture hardens before all the apples are dipped, stir over low heat until the mixture is melted)




