







# Wisdom in Nature

If you're reading this article, the chances are that you live in Lake Forest, one of the largest subdivisions in the state of Alabama, and the U.S. That being said, you're probably used to the name "Lake Forest" rolling off the tongue, just as one would speak of the name of another common subdivision. See how the bees diligently perform their duties for the greater good of the hive; they work together with flowers, and both will benefit. See how the ants know their place, and with a sense of duty, travel long distances to ensure the prosperity of their colony. The discipline of arthropods is to be admired and mirrored. See how the sun rises and falls daily. Consistency is one of the highest forms of charity.

So, try taking a little bit more time out of your day to admire the greenery, the bugs, and the fresh air that sustains them — you can probably find it in your front yard. I guarantee you'll be better for it. Good results are worth waiting for!

## CHEF CLINT'S CORNER



Chef Clint

### Spinach and Artichoke Dip

#### Ingredients

- » 9 oz. Cream Cheese
- » 4 oz. Heavy Cream
- » 2 oz. Chicken Stock
- » 6 oz. Artichokes
- » 4 oz. Spinach
- » 1/3 tsp. White Pepper
- » 2 tbsp. Shallots
- » 1 tbsp. Garlic
- » 2 oz. White Wine
- » 30 oz. Pits Wedge Cut

Soften cream cheese and whip in heavy cream to thin. In sep-



arate sauce pan, sauté chopped shallots, garlic and artichokes. Next, deglaze with wine and wilt in spinach. Combine sauté mixture to



cream mixture and chicken base. Lightly pulse with Buerre mixer allowing some texture in the dip. Serve warm in fried Pita chips.

**You can also add Crab meat to this recipe to make Crab and artichoke Dip.**

### Chilton County Peach Preserves

#### Ingredients

- » 12 each Chilton County Peaches (pitted, peeled, sliced)
- » 2 1/4 cups Sugar
- » 2 oz. Pectin
- » 1 each Lemon Juiced

Crush 1 cup of the peaches above in sauce pan over medium heat then add remaining peaches. Gradually add sugar and cook until soft. Slowly add pectin, bring to boil, then remove from heat. Finish with lemon juice
