

Notes from the President LF POA January 2019

Friends and Neighbors,

Wanted to begin this letter to you with some positive news for our community that is planned for 2019 by our City. Daphne Representatives have been working on both Road and Sidewalk Improvement Plans that will include Lake Forest in the coming years. Updates as follows:

Road Improvements 2019 and beyond: As I travel about I often get asked questions about any future road paving plans by the City. Serving duties as our Liaison with the City, it is nice to be able to report to you, that our City Councilmembers have made allowances in the 2019 city wide budget that will allow for road re-surfacing projects to be developed as part of a phased 20 year repair cycle plan for “all city” owned and maintained roads. Approximately \$750K, or possibly, closer to an amount up to \$1 Million dollars will be earmarked for road re-surfacing projects in 2019. Currently our city maintains about 140 total miles of roads throughout 7 Districts. The 20 year phased approach will enable nearly 5% of city owned roads to be re-surfaced annually.

The selection of which roads will be scheduled for re-paving is to be based primarily on road condition classifications. The worst roads will be targeted for re-surfacing and so on. At this time, we do not know which roads will be selected for re-surfacing in 2019, however, with this approach road surface improvements throughout our area will be welcomed as they will surely compliment the earlier re-surfacing efforts that occurred on Ridgewood and Bayview Drive. The city re-surfacing 20 year plan includes all roads within Lake Forest. You can get more information regarding this by contacting the Councilmembers that represent you and Lake Forest; Robin Lejeune - District 6, Ron Scott - District 5, Joel Coleman - District 3 and Doug Goodlin - District 4.

Sidewalks for Lake Forest in 2019 and beyond: Since installed our sidewalks have been transformative. They have become one of the most popular recreational items in Lake Forest enjoyed by many. The “Goal” was to create a more walkable community by installing Trails or Sidewalks from the Lawson Rd/ County Rd 13 intersection through Lake Forest to connect with Jubilee Shopping Center, to the Lake, to the Central Park and ultimately to the North Main Highway 90 Gator Boardwalk. Improving our walkability also provides safe routes to schools and to our own amenity locations such as our 3-three pools and parks. After a two year hiatus in Lake Forest for this type of work current City is planning to install additional sidewalk segments in our neighborhood in 2019 and beyond. In 2017, our city’s Public Works Department focused on ensuring city-wide sidewalks were compliant with the American Disabilities Act. In 2018, additional sidewalks were planned and installed for District 2 (Old Town).

As part of City Budget and Public Works planning our Councilmembers developed a multi-year phased plan for additional sidewalks. Councilman Lejeune and Councilman Scott have worked especially hard to ensure Lake Forest continues to see advances in this area of our city infrastructure. Going forward from here, in 2019, the sidewalk segment targeted next for installation in Lake Forest will be from our Windsor Entrance extending to Ridgewood Drive and then to the intersection with Bayview Drive. In 2020, the sidewalk segment currently planned for installation will be from Ridgewood Pool to the Bayview Entrance and then in 2021, the sidewalk segment currently planned would include Bayview Drive connecting to Ridgewood Drive until you get to Montclair Pool where there is a seg-

ment in place to connect with. Future segments will also be considered. In order to facilitate the install there may have to be some removal of obstructions in the medians, therefore, if significant tree work is needed then re-planting of trees will occur once the segments are completed. The concept is still to weave in a safe meandering sidewalk, mostly in the medians and to limit the disturbances to existing vegetation. Once completed we will become better connected to each other and to our city.

Special Called Meeting of the Members was Re-Scheduled for 17 Jan 2019 at 7 p.m. at 19th Hole

Architectural Covenants Changes Requested and Recommended; Your Ballot must be returned no later than 17 Jan 2019; See sample Ballot on our website; By now you should have received your ballot with envelope. We postponed the vote and extended the time-frame in order to provide

additional time for you to consider the proposed changes. These changes, if approved, will improve the overall charm, character, and value of our neighborhood. We are asking you to support changes to these 4-four areas; **1. Improved Lot Appearance;** such as limiting parking in non-designated areas. **2. Definition of a Single Family Home;** prevent too many unrelated adult individuals from sharing one single family home zoned dwelling. **3. Allowing for Sanctions in the form of targeted Fines;** for non-compliance. **4. Re-coup legal costs and fees;** if the POA has to pursue legal remedies in court for non-compliance.

Please read the Ballot carefully, then Vote, and return to the office by 17 January, 2019 or you can vote at the Special Called Meeting at 7pm, on 17 January, 2019. Voting will conclude at the close of that meeting. Results will be provided the next day. If approved by you, then the POA staff will have better tools that will enable improvements to the material conditions of degraded properties.

Renovation Items for Ridgewood Pool and Parks; Final project renovation items are completed at Ridgewood Pool. Cool deck surface and replacement of the mushroom spray feature due to a scratch that occurred during install is complete. Bench seating for all of our parks is nearly completed.

Holiday Lights Decoration Contest, Wrap Up; we had another highly successful year for this contest using our LF FACEBOOK page to collect “likes” for the winners. We had lots of participation throughout the neighborhood and all the Holiday Lights looked great. Lake Forest Gift Certificates for \$300, \$200 and \$100 dollars were awarded the winners for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place based on your “likes.” Shout out to Pagan Circle that seems to do an awesome job every year.

In closing, I have chosen for personal and professional reasons to resign my current position as the President of our Association. It has been a privilege to volunteer to serve our community and to represent our POA. During my tenure in leadership, I have strived to communicate with you as an honest broker, however, continued positive efforts are still needed that could **1.** resolve systemic operational issues, **2.** to improve communications to you, **3.** to charter replacement of and or repair of our key amenity items and **4.** to continue to strengthen our relationship with the City.

For me, I know, “That all a person can do, is all you can do, and then that’s enough.” **Final thoughts;** include much heartfelt thanks to those of you that have given me your support and encouragement in the past, and please remember, “**WE**” are, all in this together and “**Our**” future can be as bright as Holiday Lights, as we volunteer to work together to make it.



into low- 50's. There has been some fair fishing and the weather was good till the strong winter fronts showed up. The bay and rivers are muddy due to the wind and rain, but the salinity of the water is about .05 parts per thousand in the Delta. This means flounder are back down to the gulf and the redfish are all alone in the Delta and trout have moved to the deeper channels of the creeks and rivers. What this really means is the cooler weather makes for

cooler water temperatures and the fish bite becomes slower and making live bait harder to find. Also, be aware of the tide changes this time of year because the water levels can drop quickly and leave you stranded on a sand bar or a mud flat which is not very pleasant this time of year.

Till next month, stay warm and keep a tight line.






