6. New Playground Equipment preparations and installation to be completed by May 2018 for all pool locations.

“President’s Questions and Answers Segment for the Members,”

reflected below some of the more prominent items that seem to be of elevated interest.

1. **Is the 19th hole in need of replacement?** Yes. The structure has been professionally inspected and assessed with a finding of replacement due to structural component deterioration. A replacement project is being developed as part of our long range planning efforts for this amenity.
2. **Does LF need to update Architectural Covenants?** Yes. Other improvements and updates to our covenants would help our property values and improve our overall neighborhood appearance.
3. **Are the Marina Piers going to be repaired?** Hurricane Nate last year caused severe damage to all of our piers. A repair project is part of our long range planning improvements for the marina as well as additional cleanup.

In closing, take a look at the outstanding information provided by Coach Kenny King in Daphne Sports Section in this edition. We are striving to have all Pools open 1 May, so don’t forget to get your updated pool pass and enjoy. Look for Ribbon Cutting announcements for our new playground equipment and for the Ridgewood Pool renovation projects. Hope all of you have enjoyed this Springtime which has been exceptional this year with cooler temperatures. Take time to enjoy the little things in life, at some point you will look back and they will be big things.

Spring Fishing Report

I would like to thank everyone who attended the March Fishing Seminar at the Lake Forest Yacht Club. The turnout was great and hopefully everyone gained a better understanding of how to fish for speckle trout, redfish, and flounder in the Bay and Delta. Also, I would like to thank Chris Harris and Bryan Smith for their help on repairing "D" dock or better known as the Fishing Pier. Thanks for your time and help.

Another thank you goes out to Lake Forest Yacht Club Inc. They have appropriated funding for 2 new purple martin bird houses. The old bird houses were destroyed during hurricane Nate. Thank you members and Commodore Fred Fassbender.

May is finally here and the water temperatures have risen into the low 80's to mid 70's. The bay and rivers

have finally cleared up after all the rain we got this year and, salinity of the water is about 8 ppt in D'Olive bay and the causeway. This means flounder are on the points to the North Pass and the redfish are all along the causeway, and trout are moving everywhere to keep up with the migrating shrimp. What this really means is the warmer weather makes for great fishing as spring arrives in the bay and Delta.

Along with warmer days the fishing action will definitely heat up on the north end of the bay. These fish can be caught in a number of ways including fishing a shrimp on a Carolina rig along the edges of drop offs, throwing jig heads with scented grubs, such as gulps along the same drop offs, the ole bass technique of using spinner baits along grass banks

and the trusty popping cork with a live shrimp. Flounder will start their migration from the Gulf and channels up the bay for deeper water for the spring and summer. When flounder fishing make sure you fish your baits on the bottom with a finger mullet or bull minnow.

Another great way to catch trout and redfish is to look for diving birds and ease or drift into them casting toward the divers. Also, look for the telltale signs of fish slicks or greasy spots on top of the water which means the trout are feeding as well on little minnows and shrimp. Redfish will be in their usual spots too, over oyster beds and shells and along the points of rivers and channels that dump into larger bodies of water. This is my fa-

vorite time of the year to fish because the conditions are perfect and the temperature is pleasant to be out on the water. Now is the time to get out and enjoy the bay and delta, because if you are not catching fish, you are not fishing.

Mark your calendars for an event that happens down at the Lake Forest Marina Fishing Pier every year in May. The annual Youth Fishing Tournament takes place May 19, 2018 at 10:00 am to 1:00 pm. This fishing tournament is open to all children between the ages of 3 to 13 and a free lunch and soft drinks will be served after the awards ceremony.
